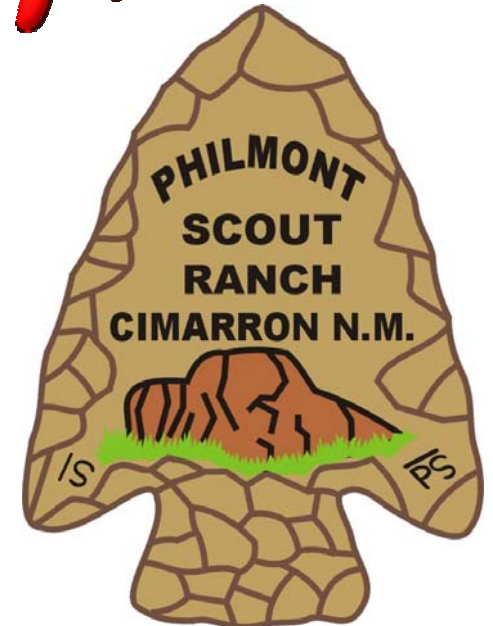

You and your crew will also experience an exciting 9-mile stretch of the mighty Arkansas River while whitewater rafting. You will be able to walk through the wondrous Garden of Gods and witness the beauty of rock formations seen nowhere else on earth. Your visit out west will also include a real chuck wagon dinner with a country western band playing for your enjoyment.
