Online Information

- You must access the Philmont Gateway and submit all of your own personal information before you will be able to submit your crew's itinerary preferences for a trek.
- Do not wait ... Get your rosters in now

Ready for itinerary selection?

You're in the right spot!

- After **Tuesday, January 29 11:00 PM MDT**, your roster page will display a timer counting down until your **11:05 AM MDT** itinerary selection time.
- At **11:00 AM MDT** (5 minutes before your itinerary selection time), clicking the green "Itinerary Selection" button will take you to the 2019 itinerary priorities page. You will have 5 minutes to carefully order your itinerary priorities before you're allowed to submit them.
- Beginning at **11:05 AM MDT** the system will allow you to submit your itinerary priorities.
- Note: The system processes itinerary priority submissions in the order they are received. This said, it may take several minutes for you to receive your itinerary assignment.



On line trek selection process

- *A timer on the top of your roster page will begin counting down 2 hours before itinerary selection opens. When the countdown reaches zero, you will be automatically redirected to the itinerary selection page.*

Itinerary Selection Worksheet

The following information is needed to complete the Worksheet:

- Crew Expedition Number
- Crew Passcode
- Name and personal contact information of the Lead Advisor
- Number of youth and adults in the crew

Itinerary Selection Worksheet

- Your six itinerary choices, listed in priority order with your first choice first
- *Note: always provide 6 choices*

Your Arrival Information:

- Name of Arrival Contact Tour Operator Contact (Ron Pardue-Blue Sky, Leading the Way)
- E-mail – use your e-mail address

Itinerary Selection Worksheet

- Arrival Time - 9:15am
- Arrival Date – the same as your crew number;
for example, July 11 for 711.
- Departure Date – Found on Watchu.org/calendar

Itinerary Selection Worksheet

- You will arrive by chartered bus
- You will arrive at Philmont
- Your first meal at Philmont will be lunch
- You do not need transportation

Itinerary Selection Worksheet

- Sister crew - ignore this item unless you have a sister crew
- If you have a sister crew, you must provide their information in advance.
- Your sister crew will need to provide their Arrival Information.

The [redacted] itinerary selection process will open [redacted] at 2:00 pm MDT

What can I do to prepare?

1. Sister Crews (optional): You have the option to request to share an itinerary with a specific 12-Day crew arriving on the same day as you.
 - a. If your crew is interested in being a sister crew, then click the button to the right to choose a desired crew.
 - b. Caution: Only two crews can share one itinerary for each arrival day. This said, Sister Crews are only assigned to itineraries with no prior assignments.
2. Find Philmont [redacted] Itinerary Information here [redacted]
3. Plan to spend time with your crew and form a list of preferred itinerary priorities before submitting these priorities online.

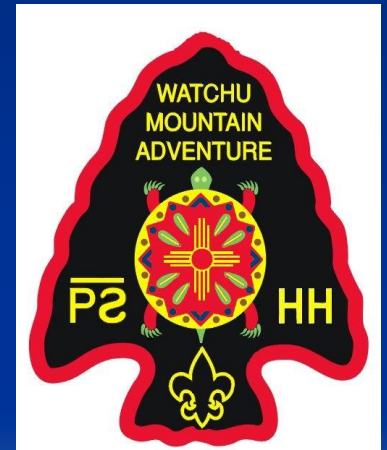
Then What?

- Expect a quick reply by e-mail confirming your trek assignment.
- A second e-mail confirming your arrival will be sent.
- If there are any issues, you must contact Philmont directly.

Then What?

- IMPORTANT – *forward both e-mails to Chief Watchu when you receive them*

All trek assignments are needed for scheduling the Watchu Mountain Adventure and determination of rendezvous with other crews during your trek



Next Steps

You will receive a package from Philmont by mid-March. This package will include materials to help you prepare for your adventure, including individual copies of the *Guidebook to Adventure*, and a 2019 Overall Philmont Map.

The *Itinerary Guidebook* will only be available via download from the Philmont website.

Review your trek's route with your crew prior to the Watchu Mountain Adventure.

Take your overall map to Philmont - it will be used in Logistics.

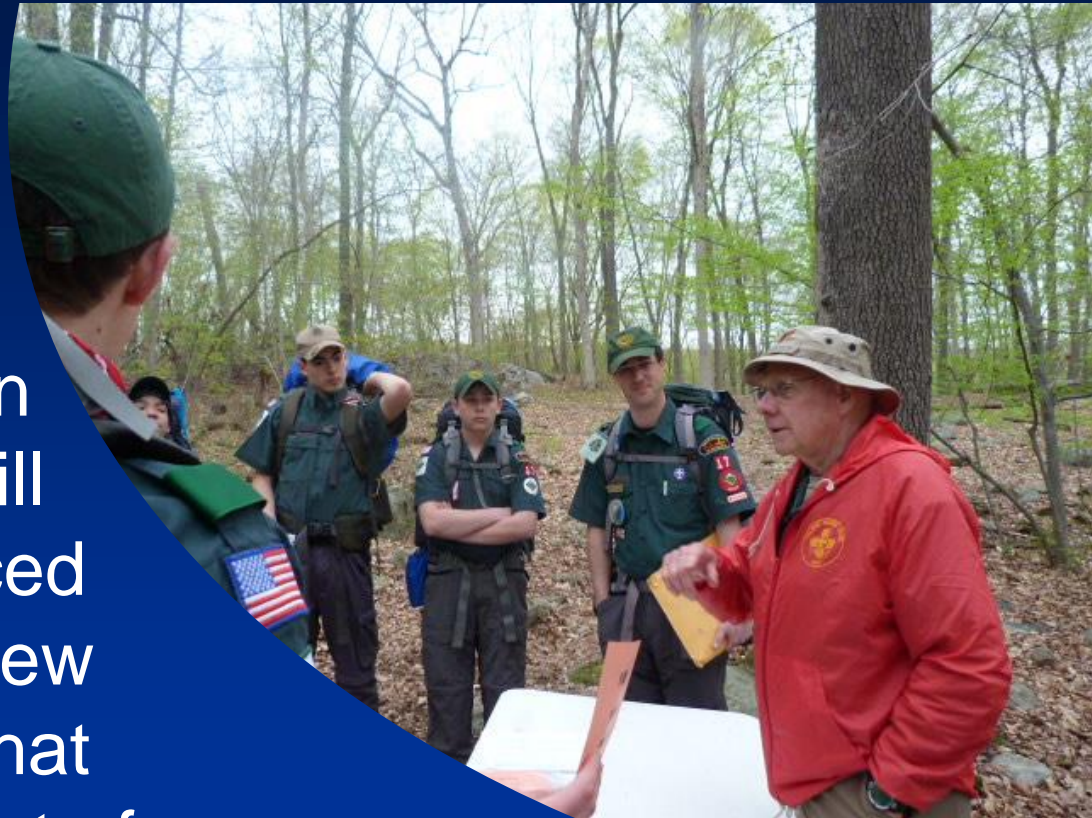
