AT NEWARK AIRPORT (TRAILBOUND)

- All crews <u>report two hours before flight time</u>. Ask airline representative for help with group check-in. If instructed, wait for the other crews to arrive.
- Check-in by crew. Lead Advisors check-in first so you can help with crew check-in.
- <u>Immediately</u> following check-in take crew through security. Will need to take off boots.
 Comply with all requests, no joking

AT DENVER AIRPORT (HOMEBOUND)

- DO NOT attempt to check-in online Patriots Path Council will do so for entire contingent.
- Report to group check-in <u>upon arrival at the airport</u>. Ask airline representative for help with group check-in.
- Check-in by crew. Lead Advisors check-in first so you can help with crew check-in.
- <u>Immediately</u> following check-in take crew through security. All must take their shoes or boots off at security. Escalators present a serious potential safety hazard for those with untied laces - instruct all to retie their laces immediately after the security check and before getting on escalator down to train (if necessary - be alert that some gates can be reached without using the train.)
