

Watchu Mountain Adventure Fact Sheet

(See "Calendar of Events" for dates of the Watchu Mountain Adventure)

- Where:** Camp Wheeler at Mt. Allamuchy Scout Reservation.
To get to Mt. Allamuchy Scout Reservation exit Interstate Highway I-80 at exit #25 going East or West. Follow the signs to Waterloo Village. Pass Waterloo Village on the left side of Waterloo Road. Entrance to Mt. Allamuchy is on the right, about 200 yards west of Waterloo Village and just before the I-80 overpass. Follow signs to Camp Wheeler and the Watchu Training Center.
- Parking:** Lots will open at 4:55 PM on Friday and close at 2:00 PM Sunday. Parking will be limited. Please arrange for your crew to arrive in as few vehicles as possible. Use vans or have parents drop your crew off and return for Sunday pickup.
- Check-In:** Begins at 5:00 PM Friday. The program begins upon arrival. Late arrival to 6:30 PM. Please arrange your work schedule to arrive as early as possible. Allow time for the congested traffic on Interstate 80. To check-in you must have:
Crew payments up to date

Philmont Health & Medical Record for all Crew Members
Advisor and Crew Passport
- Equipment:** Bring all equipment outlined in your *Guidebook to Adventure*. Note you will be required to bring your crew dining tarp with poles, tents for all crew members, crew cooking gear including pots, dish washing material, and plastic trash bags. Patriots' Path Council will NOT distribute any equipment. We will supply Coleman fuel for stoves. You MUST have ALL:
Personal Equipment listed in the *Guidebook to Adventure*
Equipment Provided by Crew listed in the *Guidebook to Adventure*
Equipment Issued at Philmont listed in the *Guidebook to Adventure*
One Cell Phone per Crew for emergency communications
- Food:** All weekend meals except Friday dinner will be provided. Your crew must bring a Friday evening bag dinner or eat before arriving. There will be a simple Friday night cracker-barrel. Except for Friday evening dinner, do NOT bring any snacks or food items that you would not have on the trail with you at Philmont
- Uniform:** Report in full Official BSA Uniform (unofficially called Class "A")
