

Conferences are determined by various departments of the National Council and conducted by an outstanding faculty of volunteer and professional Scouters.


The classrooms are equipped with top of the line technology—wireless internet, LCD projectors, surround sound audio—everything to make your conference at the Philmont Training Center successful.
