

Villa Philmonte Tour Fact Sheet



The Villa Philmonte was the summer home of our benefactors, Waite and Genevieve Phillips

Reservations:

- Trailbound or Home bound tour reservations must be made as early on Day One as possible.
- Coordinate your reservation time with your Ranger
- Typical tour schedule *(confirm with the Philmont Museum/Seton Library)*
 - One-hour tours start at 8:00am and run every hour on both the hour and half hour
 - The last tour of the day begins at 4:30pm
 - No tours are offered during lunch break (11:30am to 12:30pm)
 - A short tour is offered at 7:45am (not recommended)
- Official BSA Uniform is strongly recommended, but in a pinch a Class "B" will be OK. Look sharp!
- To make reservation send one advisor to the Philmont Museum/Seton Library across the road from Base Camp, or phone 575-376-1136
- The walk from Welcome Center to the Villa Philmonte is approximately 20 minutes, allowing time to view the Wagon Display exhibit on the way
- The commemorative patch pictured above is available at the Philmont Museum/Seton Library Gift Shop. An advisor should complete and submit the **Villa Patch Reimbursement Voucher** (http://watchu.org/Docs/Villa_Patch_Reimbursement_Voucher.pdf)

Trail Bound Tour Possibilities:

- Day One afternoon - coordinate with your Ranger
- Day Two morning - coordinate with both Logistics and your Ranger

Home Bound Tour Possibilities:

- Day Twelve afternoon, as return schedule from Backcountry Permits
- Day Thirteen morning, as bus departure time from Philmont permits
